HOW TO SAFELY REMOVE SEWN IN EXTENSIONS AT HOME

TOOLS YOU WILL NEED:

- small scissors: sewing scissors, manicure or eyebrow scissors
- small needle nose pliers
- ziplock bags & marker to label
- hair clip & comb/brush

STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS:

1. clip up the top of your natural hair so you can fully see your top row
2. locate anchor bead (the first bead closest to your hairline)
3. find the string inbetween the bead & extension weft
4. using small sewing scissors, cut that string
5. once this string is cut, locate the second bead & the string that is attached
6. cut that string
7. repeat this process arround the entire extension row
8. place your top row into a ziplock & label 'top row' (super important to label these!)
9. now take your small pliers & gently open the bead (they are fairly soft so you won't need a lot of pressure)
10. slide the bead off & repeat this until all beads are removed
11. repeat whole process if you have a second or third row
12. brush out your hair & enjoy an extension free shampoo!
